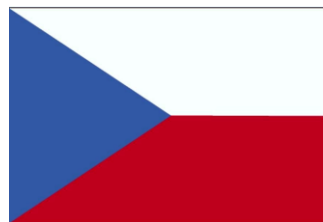




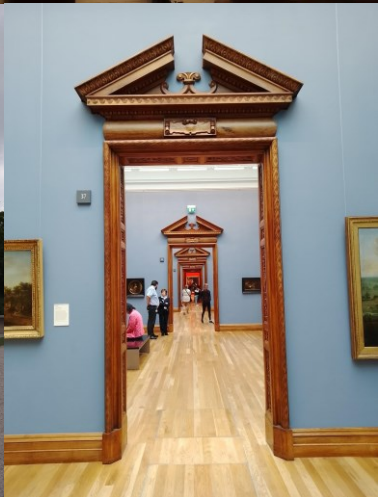

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WHAT WE HAVE LEARNT ABOUT INNOVATIVE METHODOLOGIES

- We were given useful highlights of some innovative methodologies to use in our daily teaching.
- Group work is more effective than individual learning
- Teach not just subject matter but teach how to be better citizens
- Teaching materials should be accessible for differently abled students
- It is better to use formative evaluation than grades
- Allow students alternatives to express or demonstrate their learning.
- Lifelong learning: voluntary and self-motivated pursuit of knowledge for either professional or personal reason
